## “A New Generation for Transformation” Special Fiji Trip Report!

Dear friends,

In June, Adam Moser and I lead a team of young “Calebs” to Fiji to see and experience transformation first-hand. The Lord promised us a “divine exchange” of spiritual “DNA” between the Healing the Land Team in Fiji and our team. As always the Lord did far and above anything we could have asked or imagined!

The purpose of the trip was to expose young adults to the Healing the Land Team who are leading the tremendous transformation movement in Fiji and many other nations. The second purpose was to allow them to participate in the supernatural transformation process of a village (see below). And finally this trip marked the beginning of the fulfillment of the word of the Lord to our ministry to “build a healing the land team for the United States”. This was the first step—introducing hungry young adults to God’s Kingdom purpose in transformation! This team wasn’t lacking in fire or passion before the trip—but they have been marked forever by this experience, praise God!

Some of these young adults will possibly join our team, others will come to the Transformation Intensive in January for further training, some will join the Fusion Healing the Land Team next Spring and others will influence their friends and ministries in the communities where they live.

No matter what level of involvement they will choose in the future we are encouraged by all the Lord did in them and through them and for what He has in store for our team and nation in the days ahead! He is Faithful to fulfill His promises! We are committed to laboring for this team to be trained and mobilized by next Spring to serve communities who desire to go through the transformation process!

- We saw God’s Word *work* in the lives of humble, obedient people
- Experienced an intense, fasted lifestyle of obedience and devotion
- Experienced the manifest presence of God in transformed villages
- Heard first-hand accounts from elders about the transformation of their village, we saw, we heard and we felt transformation!
- We imparted harp and bowl to the HTL transformation process!
- Experienced an open spiritual climate where even Hindu’s and Muslim’s were open to prayer, healing and the gospel!
- We were challenged by the non-western value system. No mirrors or watches but an abundance of humility!
- Received a deposit of faith—transformation *is real!*
- First-hand participation in a transformation process in a village!
- Saw immediate and powerful response from heaven from prophetic prayer and worship focused on a community!

## *Participating in the Transformation of a Village!*



Our "hut of prayer"! We worshiped and prayed for the glory of Gods to come to Tavua! He did! The very first night!

We traveled most of the day across the mountains to the village of Tavua. When we crossed into the region we felt the shift in the spiritual atmosphere. We could feel the ancient strongholds in this dark land. Idols were prominent and "guarding" villages, the people looked oppressed, and the spiritual climate felt hostile. As we arrived into the village and the spiritual atmosphere was intense! We quickly unpacked and started our "hut of prayer"!

The prayer and worship settled our hearts, and a strange, hostile environment quickly became a sanctuary of the Lord's presence – an "embassy of heaven". It was awesome!! We worshipped and prayed all evening. We felt the Lord's nearness, and knew we were there on assignment from heaven. As we entered into worship the Lord strengthened us and began to give prophetic insight into the spiritual climate and what was on God's heart. Lord opened our eyes to the ancient foundations and gave revelation about the new foundation He was establishing through His word in the community.

For the next 2 1/2 days, half of our team prayed on-site at the village gathering, and the other half kept the "fire burning on the altar," in the "hut of prayer". In the morning and evening the people of the village would gather and hear the word of the Lord. The very first day, the HTL leaders preached a strong word about idolatry!

That evening after another powerful message, the ENTIRE VILLAGE REPENTED for idolatry!!! We were privileged to be able to pray with the people. We stood in the middle of a corporate people who were weeping bitterly before God for their idolatry and unfaithfulness to the Lord. As the altar time ended people started shouting to look to the sky. There was a sign in the heavens!! A giant circle (halo) had surrounded the moon, almost the circumference of the area where we were meeting. The HTL leaders said "it's an open heaven" (It looked like the eye of God looking down on the village. The villagers knew God had heard their cry!!

### *Spiritual Atmosphere Change!*



The next morning we gathered early to pray. As we worshiped we noticed the chatting of people in the village – it sounded so different. As we listened we realized there was a difference in the spiritual atmosphere! There was light and joy coming out of the people, even early in the morning. Our team prayer-walked through the village two by two blessing what God was doing, and we felt there was a lightness and joy in the atmosphere that was not there the previous day! The Lord was breaking through as a result of the corporate repentance the night before, and we were so encouraged! We had a powerful time of prophetic prayer and worship that morning in the hut of prayer! The village gathering was also powerful as the HTL leaders taught the people about the consequences of covenant breaking and sexual immorality. Again, at the altar call EVERYONE came forward and repented!

Since we left Tavua we have received several updates of all that God is doing! Even they are surprised by how quickly God broke in and the powerful manifestation of His presence! Something was deposited as our teams worshipped and prayed together—the heaven's were open and Jesus came to Tavua! The HTL team said this is a whole new level of transformation when they incorporated the "hut of prayer" into the process! Amen!

### *Transformation Testimonies from the HTL Team - Note: the following all occurred in less than two weeks...*

- "The presence of the Lord is hovering over the whole community, resulting in healings and blessing that took the community by surprise. Suddenly after I spoke, the Lord's presence broke loose in the meeting place, softening people's hearts, God took OVER....Amen!"
- "This morning people begin to come and share what God had suddenly done for them. So many blessings and miracles. The pastors had a hard time controlling the people because nearly everybody wants to share testimonies of extraordinary things that they are experiencing in the villages."
- "Last night I just got to preach for about 25 minutes when the presence of the Lord intervene and I just couldn't continue and at that same time people were shaking everywhere inside the makeshift and I just ended up calling them forward, everybody came running from all direction, yes they did not walk but literally ran to the altar.....and the presence of the Lord just swept everybody to the floor.....As that was happening, our prayer team that were praying at the porch of the house where your team at the house of prayer. As they prayed their eyes were opened and they saw Jesus standing at the pulpit and a river burst out from where Jesus was and right into the tent. They didn't even know what was actually taking place in the meeting venue. Jesus showed up and everybody was drawn to HIM."
- "When we began visiting the homes, people just openly confessed their sins....husband and wives asking forgiveness from each other for committing adultery with another man or woman. The Lord's presence just broke loose in all the homes as people ask and accept forgiveness from family members. Yes, there was a revival of repentance!"
- "After just 1 week of the process the transformation has begun. The majority of the villagers are sugarcane farmers, and for several years they have been asking the government's assistance by providing a truck to transport their cane to the mill. Yesterday, thanks to the faithfulness of God in His Word, they received not one, but two 7 ton trucks for the villagers to keep!"
- "The farmers did not harvest their cane last season because of financial constraints faced by them in the cost of labor. That same day, the mill called these farmers to come and collect their checks because their cane is going to be harvested. Now they have the money for labor and the trucks, harvesting will start as soon as the HTL process is over. One of these farmers is the chief of the tribe himself."
- "Yesterday morning we saw three qualified but unemployed brothers in one family receive calls to work in Suva and Nadi!"
- "Fish, crabs, and other sea creatures that they had once enjoyed but had been taken away from them for almost 20 years are now back in the reefs. They all just turn up, in huge quantity. Two other surrounding villages are being blessed because of this. The woman folk of the village went out to catch crab on Tuesday (6th July 2010), they came singing and praising the Lord cause He has healed their land resulting in the abundance of crabs they caught. I was told that the catch they had on Tuesday was rare and for the first time for them to see that after all these years of dwelling on that land."

## Experiencing Transformation First-hand!

### Nuku




We are standing at the monument commemorating the day God's presence came to the village 7 years ago. When God responded to the cry and obedience of His people He came as fire from heaven, igniting the sea in front of many witnesses. The entire village, people, land, education, economy, etc. have been transformed. This village is now dedicated to the Lord and the transformation continues! An elder of the village shared with us the story before and after the fire of God fell from heaven. We had a time of worship and prayer on the beach. Then we spent time soaking up the atmosphere and meditating on the goodness of the Lord!

The *entire* community rises at 4 a.m. every morning to pray and then at 6 p.m. they gather and pray. They are committed to maintaining the presence and favor of God! When we walked through the gate of the village we were *overwhelmed* with the manifest presence of God—after 7 years! It was much stronger than the previous times I have been in Nuku. The water continues to run clear and pure even though the source upstream is still rust-colored and polluted! We were so impacted by the peace and presence of the Lord in Nuku, we didn't want to leave!

### Transformation in the National Police Force!

In spite of the coup several years ago, God continues to respond to the cry of the praying church! The transformation in Fiji has not slowed down and the river of God is making new, deeper impact in the nation than ever!

Concerned about the rising crime and corruption in Fiji, the national police commissioner proposed a new strategy for crime prevention: JESUS! The new "Jesus Strategy" was launched a year ago, and to date the crime has been reduced over 30%. It is estimated that 70% of the Fijian Police Force are now born-again Christians! Many Muslim and Hindu police officers have been brought into the Kingdom as well.

Their goal is to ensure that the entire *Fijian Police Force* has the opportunity to know Jesus. Then, their assignment is to make Him known in every precinct in Fiji. With God's help they are believing for a crime-free Fiji by 2012! The new "program" involves evangelistic crusades led by the police force in uniform in every precinct in Fiji. The police jazz band has now become the Fiji police worship team, and they march through the streets of communities worshipping Jesus and blessing the people. There is a monthly gathering

for all police officers and their families in Suva to pray for Fiji and worship the Lord together!

The police Sergeant and two police officers spent the morning with us sharing their heart and convictions. It just blew our minds to hear them share what was happening! The commissioner shared the following convictions about why this dramatic change has occurred in the nation:

- The Jesus Strategy is to act as Jesus did, then the public will be helped. (imagine that!!)
- The police officers have become counselors to the people, sharing the Word of God and seeing lives changed by His power. (imagine that!!)
- The Hindus and Muslims do accept the Christian police because the reduction in crime is a blessing to them as well.
- The Police visit the churches on Sundays to share their vision and to present a new heart and face of the police force to the people. In the past people would see the police, and be fearful because of corruption and brutality, etc. Now they are surprised to see the police officers worshipping the Lord and caring for the people of the community.
- The Police want people to understand that they are cared for and protected as friends.
- Police barracks have converted the mess halls from rooms used for smoking and drinking and they have become "prayer rooms"
- When someone is arrested, they are given the opportunity to be born-again and allow Jesus to change their life. If they do go to prison, they are encouraged to grow in the Lord and attend prayer meetings. The prisons have the "yellow ribbon program" that assists offenders in the process of reconciliation with the victim's and their families. The goal is once a person is released from prison they are without stigma and become a contribution member of society!
- The recidivism rate has dropped dramatically!
